## Hudson enters “Virtual Console” business for Nintendo’s new system - code-name “Revolution”

Hudson Soft Co., Ltd. (Head Office: Chuo-ku, Tokyo; Representative Director and President: Hidetoshi Endo) is pleased to announce that it will be entering the “Virtual Console” business, with Nintendo Co., Ltd.’s (Head Office: Kyoto-shi, Kyoto; President: Satoru Iwata) upcoming new gaming console, code-name “Revolution.”

The Nintendo Revolution’s “Virtual Console” will enable users to download and enjoy a host of games originally released for past game consoles in an “on-demand” fashion via the Revolution’s network.

For the “Virtual Console,” Hudson is planning to offer games originally released for the “TurboGrafx” (including CDROM<sup>2</sup> titles), a console jointly developed by Hudson and the NEC Corporation (formerly NEC Home Electronics, Ltd.). More than 670 titles, including 122 first-party Hudson titles were released for the “TurboGrafx” series. Through the “Virtual Console,” Hudson hopes to tap into its rich library of games for players old and new alike.
