Bomberman, the classic character who has won the hearts of video gamers across the globe is set to make his return on the PSP® with a host of new features. Utilizing the powerful graphical capabilities of the PSP®, the new version includes all new 3D levels, as well as a “Classic Game” mode where players must clear stages just like in the original NES version.



Additionally, using just one copy of the game, up to four people can play at once using one of two communication methods; game sharing or ad hoc mode.

3 Game Modes

1) Normal Game

The Normal Game consists of 100 stages set on 10 different worlds. Worlds such as “Water World”, “Sand World” and “Volcano World” feature traps and powerful bosses blocking your progress. Collected items can be stored and used strategically at the player’s discretion using the all new Stock Item System.

2) Classic Game

This is an extra mode that you can play after clearing the Normal Game. With a total of 50 stages plus bonus stages, this is a simple game based on the original version released in 1985 for the NES. Making the most of the PSP®’s wide screen and powerful 3D graphics capabilities, the whole game has been drawn in 3D. With added angles from which you can view the game, it can be enjoyed on an even deeper level.

3) Battle Game

Engaging friends in this classic bomb battle mode is the essence of Bomberman. In addition to the familiar checkerboard-style stages, many traps await players in over 20 different types of battle stage. As many as four people can play together at once with just one UMD using the game sharing function. You can also play in ad hoc mode where handicaps can be set and the number of items that appear can be changed. It also features a “Maniac” function where you can finely tweak the rules.
