(Head Office: Chuo-ku, Tokyo; Representative Director and President: Hidetoshi Endo) is pleased to announce that the new Role Playing Game (RPG), "Tengai Makyo: The Apocalypse IV," was released for the PSP<sup>®</sup> on Thursday, July 13, 2006. The price is 5,040 yen (4,800 yen before tax).

The Tengai Makyo series, known as "Far East of Eden" outside of Japan, is Hudson's largest RPG franchise already boasting sales in excess of two million units. In a bold departure, "Tengai Makyo: The Apocalypse IV," which is known for its eastern overtones, takes the action across the Pacific to America.

Originally released in January 1997 for the Sega Saturn, this updated release features new scenarios and characters, making this complete edition a standalone adventure for the PSP<sup>®</sup>!



### <"Tengai Makyo: The Apocalypse IV" - Features>

#### **1. A unique Tengai Makyo game – A brand new story released as the “complete edition” for the PSP<sup>®</sup>.**

The central theme of the main Tengai Makyo series is its classical Japanese style. Tengai Makyo is an epic RPG series which follows the heroic descendants of the Fire Clan. Unlike previous versions of the game, where the story takes place in the fictional world of Jipang, this time, the story is set in America. This PSP<sup>®</sup> version boasts more quests and characters than the Sega Saturn original, truly making it a “complete edition.” In addition to the huge, sixty-hour main story of the game, the mystery of the “Hero of Fire’s” birth (left unanswered in the Sega Saturn original) is finally revealed.

#### **2. A dream development team**

Tengai Makyo's planner/supervisor Ohji Hiroi and familiar character designer Torajiro Tsujino have once again jumped onboard for the project, this time with acclaimed voice actors Leo Morimoto (Love & Pop), Tomo Sakurai (Macross 7, Samurai X), Shuichiro Moriyama (Kingdom Hearts, Porco Rosso), Koichi Yamadera (Kingdom Hearts, Ghost in the Shell) and more - assembling a magnificent cast of fifty voice actors. In addition, a rousing score by the Warsaw Philharmonic Orchestra plunges the player into the simmering drama!

### 3. All-new animated movie cutscenes and compelling new characters

In addition to the vast number of animated cutscenes, more high quality movie sequences have been produced for the new storylines. New characters make their appearances while others bid tearful farewells, which serves to stir up the player's feelings and immerse them in the drama. Ample opportunities for battle will keep players engaged as enemies constantly crowd the screen!

### 4. A brief plot outline

Rizing is a novice hunter. His teacher, Red Bear, brings him along to New Orleans, a strange place where they lock up all the kids behind fences.
