Tengai Makyo II: Manji-maru (Far East of Eden) (RPG)

On sale now for GameCube, On sale October 2 (planned) for PlayStation 2

Tengai Makyo II: Manji-maru marks the first release in the revival of one of the most compelling role-playing games of yesteryear, Far East of Eden. With the Tengai Makyo series set to take its place alongside Bomberman and Momotaro Dentetsu as the third pillar of the Hudson brand, this new release faithfully recreates the world of the 1992 original with cutting-edge style.

The game also features a mini action game based on a hit Nintendo title.

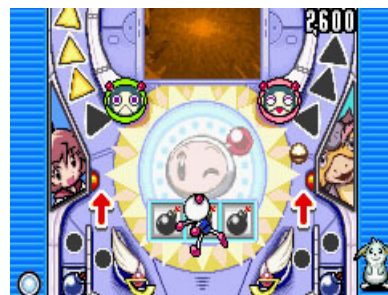
